Judging Criteria:

- The best named sandwich
- The best presented sandwich
- The best filling combinations
- Homemade/homegrown ingredients

The Rules:

1. Sandwiches can be meat, vegetarian or vegan based.
2. All ingredients must be listed along with your sandwich.
3. Ingredients should be locally sourced wherever possible, and where possible, the sources should be listed.
4. Judging will take place on Friday 22nd June 2018 at the Town Hall, Huntingdon.
5. Sandwiches must be delivered in an airtight covering.
6. Entrants must deliver their sandwiches to the Town Hall a minimum of 30 minutes ahead of judging and a maximum of 60 minutes.
7. Entrants must comply with the four-hour rule for making sandwiches, i.e. no sandwich should be made more than four hours before judging and they must be kept refrigerated up until the time that the sandwich leaves your premises to be transported to the Town Hall. Use of cool boxes is recommended.
8. Entrants may not leave their sandwiches unattended until they have been allocated a competition number and provided a sandwich entry form.
9. The winning entrants will enjoy the prestigious title of "Huntingdon's Award-Winning Sandwich Maker" for the remainder of 2018 and will receive a prize/certificate.
10. Entrants or a representative must be available during and after the judging for photographs to be taken with the judges.
11. Photograph permissions must be provided in writing for all entrants/representatives attending the judging.
12. Sandwiches should be protected from contamination by covering or storing in suitable containers.
13. Although the sandwiches won't be consumed, entrants are encouraged to visit the Food Standards Agency for guidance on food hygiene and preparation
