1	Cambridgeshire Search and Rescue	<p>CamSAR is the Lowland Rescue unit covering our county and assisting sister teams in the wider region. We are a specialist team, called upon by Police in the search for vulnerable missing people: a child, an elderly person suffering from dementia or even someone who is considering taking their own life. In each case an emergency response is vital. Our Search Technicians, Team Leaders, Search Planners, Support Team, Operations Managers and Search Managers are available 24/7, 365 days a year to respond to the missing person's emergency. The team is made up 100% of dedicated fully trained volunteers and receives no central government funding, relying entirely upon grants, fund raising and individual donations. We also help with flood evacuations.</p> <p>The money would be put towards the purchase of an underwater search pole.
