There were none.

16. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

Councillor A Beevor declared an interest in the Huntingdon Community Group (Huntingdon Muslim Community Association), Oxmoor Community Group and Huntingdon Community Group (Unity in the Community) applications.

18. **MINUTES**

Copies of the minutes of the meeting of the Grants Sub Committee held on 12<sup>th</sup> October 2017 (M2) had been circulated following their informal approval by the Chairman. It was proposed, seconded and

19. **APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

Copies of applications for a total of £8880 from 11 Organisations were available to Members at the meeting. Members were reminded of the criteria for eligibility for a grant, and informed that the total remaining in the grants budget was £1977.62. Members were also reminded that grants awards were capped at £500.
